



The strategic network of Galliker's eleven national branches with direct rail connections enables efficient and sustainable provision of transport and logistics solutions by road and rail.


With direct access to the Galliker branches on the Swiss railway network, Galliker is focusing on combined road and rail transport. The central hub in the national distribution network is located at the headquarters in Altishofen. With eleven branches Galliker is ideally placed to supply its customers as quickly as possible and with a high level of efficiency.

#### JUST IN TIME FROM A TO Z

The goods are collected from the sender by truck. It then transports the goods to the nearest Galliker branch. During the night, the goods are then distributed by rail, after which the trucks take over the fine distribution to the consignee at the corresponding branch.

#### INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTS

Our seven international branches form the foundation for international transports on our main axis Scandinavia - Belgium - Switzerland - Italy. On this axis, we are on the road every day with our fleet of trucks, flexibly and variably with full and part loads in different temperature zones.




#### **ENVIRONMENTALLY CONSCIOUS ON THE ROAD**
